SCOPE OF MISSION:

The primary purpose is construction of seminary buildings in Santa Clara, Cuba. Each team will need at least one skilled construction person. There will be opportunities to visit and get to know Cuban Baptists and work in Cuban Baptist churches. We will have opportunities to share our faith and probably some preaching opportunities for pastors/preachers. All levels of construction skills will be accepted.

COST AND TIMELINE:

December 15, 2018: You MUST have a valid passport and visa application and all other all information <u>submitted to NCBM</u>.

Cost is estimated to be \$1,500.00 (exact price to be determined when tickets are actually purchased.) In addition to the price per person, each team is required to furnish \$3,000.00 to purchase construction materials. Price per person and the funds for materials is to be paid as follows:

January 15, 2019 Deposit of 500.00 per person

January 31, 2019 Construction funds of 3,000.00 per team

March 15, 2019 Balance of per person funds (estimate: 1,000.00)

There will be more than one training meeting led by the team leader prior to the trip plus one orientation meeting led by Tom Beam from NCBM. The dates of the training (to be determined)t will not begin until after January 1, 2019.
